Provides seasonal shelter for up to 50 men, 18+. Provides dinner and breakfast as well as sleeping mats and blankets. No daytime storage services are provided. Clients are admitted until the shelter closes at 7:30am.

INTAKE: Nightly, 7pm. Shelter: nightly, 7pm-6am.

Previously operated as a seasonal shelter for adult men, is now open year round, but has the capacity to add beds when needed. No meal, hygiene or daytime storage services are provided. Service animals and pets are allowed. Line up just south of the courthouse and Jefferson Street, next to the large garage

door on Jefferson. Access to the shelter takes place through the loading dock on Jefferson St., just up from 4th Avenue. **A single line is formed for access to both shelter sites.**
